
Lending machines were installed this winter in response to many requests from the Library Satisfaction Survey. In this issue, we explain how to use the lending machine.



Here's What's Convenient! Lending Machine

1. Easy and smooth self-checkout
2. Clear loan receipts with item titles and due date
3. Up to 20 items per checkout

Location



Let's Try the Lending Machine

- 1 Touch the screen
- 2 Hold your student ID or staff ID over the reader
- 3 Select the number of items you want to borrow
- 4 Place the items on the designated area
- 5 When all items are displayed on the screen, press the 'Lending' button

Q&A: Lending Machine

- Q1** What does this mark mean?
- A** The items with this mark cannot be borrowed using the lending machine. Please borrow them at the library counter.
- Q2** The number of scanned items does not match the actual number.
A If the numbers do not match after several attempts, please visit the library counter.
- Q3** "There are items that cannot be checked out" is displayed.
A This mark indicates that the materials can only be used inside the library. Copying is allowed.

If you have any questions, please feel free to ask a librarian.

A Book Sterilizer Has Been Installed!

Books are sterilized with ultraviolet light and deodorized with airflow. Sterilization time: approx. 30 seconds

Up to six books can be sterilized at once. It also helps reduce odors from old books. Recommended during seasons when infectious diseases are common. You may also use it for your own books. Please use it together with the lending machine.
